beaded brooch

Seed Beads, Pearl Beads,
24 Gauge Jewelry Wire, Pin Back, Hot Glue

1. Thread a 5" length of wire with seed beads, and create a loop shape, twisting the ends together to secure.
2. Create four more separate loops, using 1" less wire for each loop. The first loop will be 4". The second loop will be 3"; etc.
3. Cut one piece of wire, 2" in length. You'll use this to wire the loops together into a petal shape in the next step.
4. String 6-7 beads to the center of the cut wire, and begin twisting the wire around first the top and then bottom of the smallest loop. Now wrap the second loop at the top and bottom. Continue with each loop, securing all of the loops together.
5. Repeat steps 1 through 4 to make each petal as shown in the picture below.
6. Join all of the petals together with wire, and wrap to the pin back.
7. Thread a two inch length of wire with beads, and wrap around the pin back, covering the petal bases. Add 2 small pearl beads to the center.
8. Gently bend the petals with your fingers to the desired shape.



braided belt

Braided Belt, Pearl Beads, Crystal Rondelles,
Head Pins, Jewelry Wire, Crimp Beads,
Clear Thread, Needle

1. Thread needle with clear thread, knotting the end.
2. Pull the needle up through the center of the belt to the front and thread a pearl. Pull needle back down into the belt. Knot the thread on the back to secure and cut. Continue stitching desired number of pearls onto the center of belt, spacing as desired.
3. Once center pearls are attached, thread jewelry wire with pearls and rondelles to a length slightly longer than the length of the belt.
4. Crimp wire to the belt edge in a scallop style as pictured.
5. String pearl beads and rondelles onto a head pin. Loop the head pin onto the belt at every crimped bead along scalloped edge and let dangle.



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
